Passed 10th April, 1902.

An Act to amend Chapter 59 of the Consolidated Statutes, of 'Parish Courts.'

An Act to amend the Act I. Edward VII., Chapter 27, intitled "An Act in addition to and in amendment of Chapter 50 of the Consolidated Statutes, intitled 'The Court of Divorce and Matrimonial Causes.'"

An Act to provide for the appointment of a Stipendiary or Police Magistrate, with civil jurisdiction, in the Parish of Cardwell, in the County of King's.

An Act to provide for the appointment of a Stipendiary or Police Magistrate, with civil jurisdiction, in the Parish of Dorchester, in the County of Westmorland.

An Act relating to The South West Boom Company.

An Act to incorporate The Union Telephone Company.
