

NOTICE is hereby given, that application will be made by the Applicants hereinafter named, to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, for a grant of Letters of Incorporation under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, under the provisions of the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies Act, and the several Acts in amendment thereof, incorporating and constituting the applicants, and such other persons as may become Shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is "The Fawcett Milling Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which such incorporation is sought, and the powers of the Company, shall be as follows:

(a) To purchase, or otherwise acquire and take over, either in whole or in part, the undertaking, business, property and assets, or, in the alternative, the Capital Stock of The Charles Fawcett Manufacturing Company, Limited, a body corporate, incorporated under the Laws of the Province of New Brunswick, having its head office at Sackville, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick, and to pay therefor, wholly or partly in cash, or wholly or partly in paid-up shares, bonds, debentures or other securities of the Company.

(b) To carry on the business of buying, selling, receiving, cleaning, trading, storing, shipping, forwarding, chopping, crushing, and grinding, all kinds of grain and farm produce and the products of same, and to carry on all business generally transacted by the owners of elevators, warehouses, grain-crushing mills and cleaning mills, and dealers in grain, flour and other kinds of produce, to build, contract, purchase, acquire, lease, equip, sell, mortgage, operate and otherwise deal in elevators, warehouses, grain crushing, cleaning and flour mills and property of all kinds in which grain and other produce is handled, manufactured, stored or used, and all plants, machines and equipment used in same; to carry on all business and to act as agents and commission merchants for any person, persons, firms or corporations for and in connection with any of the matters herein referred to.

(c) The buying, selling, building, equipping, maintaining, managing and operating of grist mills, oatmeal mills and other mills necessary for the manufacture of flour, oatmeal and other cereals and grain products, and to manufacture, buy, and sell either at wholesale or retail, flour, oatmeal and other articles manufactured from grain or cereals, and to own, sell, lease, mortgage, convey, improve and operate factories and buildings, for the production and storage of all kinds of goods that may be produced from or in conjunction with grain or cereals of any kind, and to buy, sell, trade and deal in the products of said mills or factories, and in said grains or cereals in any state of the product, and generally to transact all kinds of business necessary for the carrying on of any or all of the businesses aforesaid.

(d) To build, acquire, own, charter, navigate and use steam and other vessels and craft, to lay out, purchase, construct and operate other works and means of transport necessary for carrying on the operations of the Company, to construct, alter, maintain or improve any docks, dry docks, piers, wharves, elevators, warehouses and other buildings and works of any kind whatsoever necessary or required in the interests of the Company and generally to do all such other things as may be required or are necessary to the attainment of the objects aforesaid.

(e) To purchase, acquire, hold, sell, hypothecate or dispose of shares, stocks, assets or debentures in any other corporation carrying on a business similar to that which this Company is hereby authorized to carry on.

(f) The said Company shall have the power to acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise, land, farm lands, marsh lands, buildings, erections, structures and hereditaments of any tenure or description and any estate or interest therein, and to turn the same to any account that may seem expedient; including farming and cultivation of lands; to build houses and other structures thereon, and to sell, lease, rent, exchange, mortgage or otherwise encumber or dispose of upon such terms as may seem desirable, of the whole or any portion of such lands, buildings, erections, structures and hereditaments, and all or any of the buildings, erections or structures that are now or may be hereafter be erected thereon, and to take mortgages or other securities for unpaid balance of moneys on the whole or any portion thereof; and to prepare building sites, and to construct, reconstruct, alter, improve, decorate, furnish, insure and maintain offices, flats, houses, factories, warehouses, shops, wharves, buildings, works and conveniences of all kinds on any such lands; and to consolidate, connect or sub-divide properties as to said Company or the directors thereof may be deemed advisable.

(g) To stock the said lands and to buy, breed and deal in all kinds of horses, cattle and farm stock, and buy and sell grain and other products of the soil, as well as to buy, sell, deal in and lease agricultural implements and appliances.

(h) To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount and execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bills of lading, warrants and other negotiable or transferable instruments, and warehouse certificates.

(i) To do all or any of the matters hereby authorized, either alone or in conjunction with, or as factors, trustees or agents for any other company or persons, or by or through any factors, trustees or agents.

(j) To carry on any other business which may seem to the company capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the above or any portion thereof, or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the Company's property or rights.

(k) The powers in each paragraph hereof shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraph.

3. The head office or chief place of business of the company is to be at Sackville, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick.

4. The amount of the Capital Stock of the Company is to be Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), divided into Two Thousand shares of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.

NOTICE OF GRANTING LETTERS PATENT.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, that under Chapter Eighty-five of the Consolidated Statutes of New Brunswick, 1903, and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the Great Seal of the said Province, bearing date the Tenth day of May, A. D. 1911, incorporating Allen Miller, Senior, Lumberman; William H. Miller, Lumberman; Allan Miller, Junior, Lumberman; James E. Miller, Lumberman; and T. George Miller, Lumberman; all of the Town of Campbellton, in the County of Restigouche and Province of New Brunswick, for the following purposes, namely:

To build, erect, purchase, take by lease or otherwise acquire, maintain, operate, sell or otherwise dispose of, saw mills, shingle mills, lath mills, box mills and other mills for manufacturing all products of wood in the Province of New Brunswick.

To purchase, take by lease, or buy from the Crown, or from any person or persons, company or companies, and take by assignment or transfer of leases or of licenses granted by the Crown, or by any person or persons, company of companies, or otherwise acquire, timber lands, timber limits and right to cut timber in the Province of New Brunswick, and to sell or otherwise dispose of the same.

To lumber, cut, haul, get out, to purchase or otherwise procure all kinds of timber and trees, whether growing on or severed from the soil, including saw-logs, pulp-wood, shingle logs, shingle wood, lath wood, railway ties and other kinds of wood, and to sell, manufacture or otherwise dispose of the same.

To manufacture, buy, sell, or otherwise deal or trade in deals, planks, boards, shingles, laths and other kinds of manufactured lumber and other goods and articles of all kinds in the manufacture of which timber or wood is used.

To purchase, construct, take by lease or otherwise acquire, operate, charter or navigate steam or sailing vessels, boats, or row boats of every kind and nature whatsoever, and to sell, dispose of or otherwise deal in the same.

To repair, renew or rebuild steam or sailing vessels of every kind and description, whatsoever.

To conduct and carry on a general merchandise business, wholesale or retail, or both, and the buying and selling of goods, wares and merchandise of every kind and description.

To store, warehouse, carry and transport goods, wares and merchandise of any kind whatsoever, for hire or reward, and to carry and transport passengers by land or water for hire or reward.

To construct, take by lease or otherwise acquire, maintain and for hire or reward operate wharves, docks, dry docks, graving docks and repairing docks in the Province of New Brunswick, and to sell or otherwise dispose of the same.

For the purposes of the said business to purchase, take by lease or otherwise acquire, water rights, water power, electrical power or other power.

For all or any of the purposes or objects aforesaid, to purchase, take by lease or otherwise acquire lands, tenements and hereditaments in the Province of New Brunswick; to construct, make or manufacture, purchase, take by lease or otherwise acquire, and to maintain all materials, articles, tools, engines, boilers, tackle, apparel, furniture, machinery of all kinds, cranes, hoisting gear and other appliances and facilities for loading and discharging vessels, tramways, railway sidings, piers, booms, machine shops, warehouses and buildings for the storage of goods, wares and merchandise.

To sell or otherwise dispose of the lands, tenements, hereditaments, water, electrical or other power, materials, articles, tools, machinery, engines, boilers, tackle, apparel, furniture, piers, booms, machine shops, warehouses and buildings and cranes and other appliances and facilities mentioned in the above eleventh clause.

To lease, sell, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of or encumber the undertakings of the Company, or any part thereof, and any or all of the real or personal property of the Company for such consideration and in such manner and upon such terms as to the Company may seem desirable.

To do all things and everything necessary, proper, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein enumerated or incidental to the powers herein specified, or which shall at any time appear necessary or expedient to be done for the protection or benefit of the Company, either as owner of or interested in any property or otherwise to the same extent or as fully as natural persons might or could do. By the name of "W. H.
