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NOTICE is hereby given that the persons hereinafter named will apply to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for a grant of a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent under the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies Act and amending Acts constituting the applicants and such other persons as may become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

(1) The proposed corporate name of the Company is "Cartleton County Saint John River Valley Land Company, Limited." The objects for which incorporation are sought are as follows:—

(a) To carry on the business of a Real Estate Company and for such purposes to buy, sell, lease, hold, use and generally deal in lands, and any interest therein in this Province and elsewhere; to erect, build and maintain dwellings, houses and other buildings and erections on such lands and premises and make other improvements, with full power to lease, mortgage, sell or otherwise deal in the same, or any part thereof; to lend money upon security of any real or personal property, or to act as agents for persons owning or interested in Real Estate of all kinds or any interest therein; to borrow money upon the credit of the Company, or upon the securities of its property, or any part thereof; to issue bonds, debentures or other securities for the lawful purposes of the Company, and to pledge or sell the same for such sums and prices as may be deemed expedient or be necessary; and to hypothecate any or all such bonds, debentures or securities.
