

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that application will be made by the applicants hereinafter named to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, for a grant of Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, according to the provisions of the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act and the several Acts in amendment thereof, constituting the applicants and such other persons as may hereafter become shareholders in the proposed Company a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter set forth.

1. The proposed corporate name is "Realities Limited."
2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are:

 - (f) To purchase, lease, take in exchange or otherwise acquire water powers, water rights and water privileges, and to sell, deal in, lease, exchange, mortgage or otherwise dispose of the same.
 - (g) To develop, improve and lay out the Company's property into buildings, lots, streets, lanes, squares or otherwise and to aid in the construction and maintenance and to construct and maintain lanes, roads, streets, bridges, water works or other works and improvements necessary for the occupation, settlement and improvement, or calculated to render the Company's property more accessible and valuable.
 - (h) To make advances by way of loans and to take and hold mortgages, liens or other security as may be deemed necessary.
 - (i) To issue and allot as fully paid up shares of the company in payment or part payment of any business, patent, franchise, undertaking, property, rights, powers, privileges, lease, license, contract, real estate, stocks, bonds and debentures, or other property, or rights, which it may lawfully acquire.

1. The proposed corporate name is "Restigouche Fox Company, Limited."
2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are:
 - (a) To engage in a general ranching business for the breeding and rearing of foxes and other fur-bearing animals in captivity.
 - (b) To buy, sell, exchange, import, export and deal in foxes and other fur-bearing animals, alive and captive, for breeding and rearing purposes, and for the production of fur for market, and commercial uses and purposes.
 - (c) To make, execute and enter into contracts and agreements with any persons or companies having objects similar in whole or in part to this Company, for the housing, feeding, keeping, rearing or breeding of any such captive fur-bearing animals, and for the capture and taking into captivity of wild animals for propagation and breeding purposes, and for fur.
 - (d) To carry on a trade and business in raw and manufactured furs, to buy and sell skins, pelts and hides, both manufactured and unmanufactured, and transact any business relating thereto.
 - (e) To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise such real estate as may be required for the business of the Company, and to sell, lease, encumber and mortgage the same.
