

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that application will be made to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, for a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent, under the provisions of the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, constituting the applicants and such other persons as may become shareholders in the proposed company, a body corporate and politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned:

1. The proposed corporate name of the company is "The Adamsville Telephone Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are:

(a) To establish, maintain, operate and carry on and throughout the Counties of Kent and Queen's, in the Province of New Brunswick, a general telephone business in all its branches, including the building of offices, the setting up and erecting of posts and stringing of wires thereon, buying and selling of telephone instruments, wires and such apparatus as are used and employed in carrying on said business, and generally to do such other things and all things necessary or incidental to the said business or undertaking.

(b) To transmit messages by telephone for hire over the lines of the said company from any points within the said two counties and to make connection with or to amalgamate with any other telephone Company.

(c) For the purpose of its business to build, purchase, lease, acquire and hold real and personal property of all

kinds, and rights, franchises, privileges, concessions, powers and licenses in connection with the said undertaking, with power to sell and dispose of the same, and likewise to mortgage the same from time to time.

3. The chief place of business of the said Company is to be at Adamsville, in the County of Kent, and Province of New Brunswick.

4. The amount of the capital stock of the said Company is to be four thousand dollars, divided into eight hundred shares of five dollars each, of which four hundred and twenty shares are actually subscribed.
