PUBLIC Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Section 16 of the Timber Regulations of the year 1913, an Order-in-Council was passed dated July 10th, 1913, approving of the following tariff in relation to stumpage on logs cut on Crown Lands in this Province, namely:—

Hemlock timber, per ton65
Spruce timber, per ton75
Cedar logs, per M.	1.50
Railway ties, 8 feet length, each05
Hemlock logs, per M. superficial feet	1.00
Hemlock bark, per cord80
White birch, for spool wood, per cord65
White birch logs, for spool wood, per M. Sup. Ft.	1.25
Fir logs, per M. superficial feet	1.20
Poplar logs, per M. superficial feet	1.00

And for all other descriptions of lumber not specified above 15 per cent. of the market value thereof at the mill, place of shipment, or place of consumption in the Province.

Notice is hereby given that all lumber cut on Crown Lands on or after the first of August, 1913, will be subject to the above rates of stumpage.
