NOTICE OF LEGISLATION.

NOTICE is hereby given that application will be made by the Eel River Light, Heat and Power Company to the Local Legislature of the Province of New Brunswick at its next session for the passage of a bill to amend Chapter 59 of the Acts of Assembly, 1 George V., 1911, by providing for an increase of the capital stock of said Company to \$350,000, and an increase in the rights of the Company to issue bonds to the amount of six-sevenths of the amount of the capital stock instead of three-quarters as at present.
