ST. STEPHEN FOX RANCH COMPANY, LIMITED.

NOTICE is hereby given that within one month after the last publication of this Notice in the Royal Gazette, application will be made by the applicants hereinafter named to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, for a grant of Letters Patent of Incorporation under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, under the provisions of the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, and the several Acts

in amendment thereto, incorporating the applicants and such other persons as may become shareholders in the proposed Company a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter set forth.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is "St. Stephen Fox Ranch Company, Limited," which is not the name of any other company, or liable to be confounded therewith.

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought, and the powers of the Company, shall be as follows:

(a) To engage in a general ranching business for the breeding and rearing of foxes, and other fur-bearing animals in captivity.

(b) To engage in a general ranching business for the rearing of horses, cattle, sheep and other domestic animals.

(c) To buy, sell, exchange, acquire and otherwise deal in foxes, and other fur-bearing animals.

(d) To buy, sell, acquire and deal in raw and manufactured furs, skins, pelts and hides, manufactured and unmanufactured, and to tan, cure and preserve skins, pelts and hides of all kinds, and to transact any business relating thereto, and to carry on the trade and business of buying, selling and dealing in furs and the breeding and raising of fur-bearing animals.

(e) To make, execute and enter into contracts and agreements with any person or persons or with any company or companies having businesses similar in whole or in part to those of the proposed Company.

(f) For the purposes of its business, or any of them, to deal, purchase, lease, buy, sell or otherwise acquire and hold, real and personal property of all kinds, with power to sell and dispose of the same.

(g) To acquire the good will, property, rights and assets and assume the liabilities of any person, firm or company carrying on or transacting any business similar to that conducted by the Company, and to pay for the same in cash or in stock or securities of the Company, or otherwise, and to exchange shares in the Company for any of the purposes or objects of the Company.
