APPLICATION FOR LETTERS PATENT

GRAND FALLS FRUIT GROWING AND FARM LAND COMPANY, LIMITED.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the persons hereinafter named will apply to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for a grant of Letters Patent under the provisions of the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies Act constituting the applicants and such other persons as may become shareholders in the proposed company, a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned:

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is, "Grand Falls Fruit Growing and Farm Land Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are:

(a) To carry on the business of fruit-growers or nurserymen and to establish fruit farms, nurseries, orchards and gardens in connection with the growing of fruit of every description, and to buy, sell and deal in fruits of all kinds.

(b) To enter into and carry on and conduct the business of farming, dairying and stock raising, and to buy, sell and deal in farm and dairy products and live stock of all kinds.

GUNN PAPER COMPANY, LIMITED.

NOTICE is hereby given that the persons hereinafter named will apply to the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for a grant by letters patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick of a Charter constituting the persons hereinafter named and others who may become shareholders in the company proposed to be hereby created, a body corporate and politic for the purposes and objects hereinafter named, that is to say:—

1. The proposed corporate name of the company is "Gunn Paper Company, Limited."

(e) To act as manufacturers agents and to distribute all kinds of papers, envelopes, blank books, stationery, paper bags and other accessories to the paper trade.

(f) To purchase, lease, acquire and hold real and per-

sonal property of all kinds and to take, acquire and hold securities upon any real estate or personal property or effects whatsoever.

(g) To acquire by original subscription or to take or otherwise acquire or hold shares and securities in any other companies authorized to do any business which the company is authorized to carry on, or carry out any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the company.

(h) To acquire and dispose of patent rights, trade marks and processes secret or otherwise.

(i) To acquire and dispose of any business, manufacturing or otherwise similar to that conducted by the company which may seem to the company capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the business of the company or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of the company's property or rights.
