APPLICATION FOR LETTERS PATENT

"THE NEWCASTLE COAL COMPANY, LIMITED."

NOTICE is hereby given that the persons hereinafter named will apply to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for incorporation by Letters Patent under the provisions of the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act and Amending Acts constituting the applicants and such persons as may hereafter become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter set forth. The name of the proposed Company is to be "The Newcastle Coal Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and to sell, mortgage, or dispose of lands, buildings, and real estate of all kinds, and to purchase and construct thereon manufactories, dwellings, warehouses, and buildings of all kinds, so far as may be necessary or incidental to the carrying on of the business of the Company.

To develop, control, deal in and dispose of electrical and other power for the generation, distribution and supply of electricity or light, heat and power purposes.

To buy, build, sell, charter and operate vessels for any of the purposes necessary or incidental to the Company's business, and in connection therewith to purchase, build, use, lease and dispose of wharves, trams, tramways, coal pockets, etc., for general mining and navigation purposes in connection with the business of the said Company. GUNN PAPER COMPANY, LIMITED.

NOTICE is hereby given that the persons hereinafter named will apply to the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for a grant by letters patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick of a Charter constituting the persons hereinafter named and others who may become shareholders in the company proposed to be hereby created, a body corporate and politic for the purposes and objects hereinafter named, that is to say:—

1. The proposed corporate name of the company is "Gunn Paper Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought and the powers of the company are:—

(a) To purchase, acquire and take over as a going concern, the business of manufacturers' agent of Percy P. Gunn of the Town of Sussex in the County of Kings and Province of New Brunswick, and all the stock, plant, machinery, leases, rights and powers belonging or appertaining to the said business and also to purchase and acquire the good-will of the said business.

(d) To carry on the business of manufacturing and dealing in office stationery, fixtures, equipment, supply and all thereto pertaining.

(e) To act as manufacturers agents and to distribute all kinds of papers, envelopes, blank books, stationery, paper bags and other accessories to the paper trade.

(f) To purchase, lease, acquire and hold real and per-

sonal property of all kinds and to take, acquire and hold securities upon any real estate or personal property or effects whatsoever.

(g) To acquire by original subscription or to take or otherwise acquire or hold shares and securities in any other companies authorized to do any business which the company is authorized to carry on, or carry put any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the company.

(h) To acquire and dispose of patent rights, trade marks and processes secret or otherwise.
