

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that the persons hereinafter named will apply to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for the grant of a Charter incorporating by Letters Patent according to the provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies Act" and amending Acts, the applicants and such other persons as may hereafter become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter set forth.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is "The Victoria Steamship Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which the incorporation of the said proposed Company is sought are:—

(a) To purchase, lease, take, acquire and hold the steamship "Victoria," and any other steamship or steamships, vessel or vessels, scow or scows, boat or boats which may become desirable for the successful carrying on of the undertakings of the Company or incidental thereto, and to furnish, equip and outfit any or all of the said steamships, vessels, scows and boats from time to time as may become necessary in the opinion of the said Company.

(b) To purchase, lease and otherwise acquire and hold any lands, tenements and hereditaments, and to build, construct, purchase, lease, take, acquire and hold, any steamship, vessel, scow, boat, wharf, pier, dock, warehouse, building, or other property or works, and any concession, license, or right in respect to the same or any of them, which in the opinion of the Company may be desirable for the carrying on, in any way, of the business of the Company.

(c) To carry, convey and transport passengers, mails, goods and freights of all kinds from place to place on the River Saint John and its tributaries and elsewhere, by water or by land as the Company may from time to time determine, and generally to conduct and carry on a regular passenger and freighting business of every kind both upon any steamship or other vessel owned, managed or controlled by the Company, or by towage or other means of transport by water or by land, and to provide, furnish, supply and sell food, refreshment and entertainment to and for the patrons and employees of the said Company, and to fix, determine and collect the fares, rates, and prices for any and all such services and supplies done and to be done and performed by the Company in connection with its business or incidental thereto.

(d) To sell, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge and otherwise dispose of or encumber the property and undertakings of the Company, or any part thereof, at one or different times for such consideration and in such manner and upon such terms as to the Company may seem desirable or expedient.

(e) To borrow money and to make and issue promissory notes, draw and accept bills of exchange and other evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, and when necessary to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or other security upon the property of the Company or upon any part thereof.

(f) To hold, purchase or otherwise acquire and to sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock, bonds or debentures or other evidences of indebtedness issued or created by any other company or corporation, and while the holder thereof to exercise all the rights and privileges of ownership including the right to vote thereon.

3. The head office of the Company shall be at the City of Fredericton, in the County of York, or at such other place as may hereafter be determined by By-Law of the Company.

4. The amount of the capital stock of the Company is to be twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), divided into eight hundred shares of twenty-five dollars each (\$25.00).
