4-5 GEORGE V., CHAP. 36.

An Act to Amend the Inspection and Sale Act. (Assented to 12th June, 1914.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows: 1. Section 2 of the Inspection and Sale Act, chapter 85 of the Revised Statutes, 1906, is amended by striking out the fifth line thereof and substituting therefor the words "Part III applies exclusively to flour, meal and feed." 2. The said Act is amended by Inserting the following section immediately after section 149: "149a.—In this part, "feed" means and includes the feeds or mixed or unmixed meals or other feeding products made from the entire grains of wheat, rye, barley, oats, Indian corn, buckwheat, or flaxseed or other seeds, or other feeding stuffs, and the bran and middlings from wheat, rye, oats, peas, In-dian corn, buckwheat, flax or sugar beet." 3. Section 150 of the said Act is repealed and the follow-ing is substituted therefor:

ing is substituted therefor: "150.—This part applies to flour, meal and feed imported into Canada, or manufactured or sold or offered for sale there-in, and to the reinspection or reweighing of such flour, meal and feed at any place to which it is removed within Canada, whenever such reinspection or reweighing is declared by the Governor-in-Council to be necessary in the public interest." 4.
