APPLICATION FOR LETTERS PATENT

McFARLANE WAGON COMPANY, LIMITED.

NOTICE is hereby given, that application will be made to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council by the applicants hereinafter named, for the granting of Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, in accordance with the New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act and amending Acts, constituting the applicants and such other persons as may become shareholders in the proposed Company a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned and set out.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is "McFarlane Wagon Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are as follows:

(a) To establish, carry on, operate, manage and conduct a general business for the manufacturing and repairing of carriages, wagons, sleighs, sleds, vehicles and conveyances of every kind, and for handling, buying, selling and dealing in carriages, wagons, sleighs, sleds, vehicles and conveyances of every kind, and of all the parts thereof and in connection therewith and incidental thereto, and for the purpose of carrying on such business to have the following powers:

(a) To purchase, take over or otherwise acquire as a going concern the manufacturing business carried on by the late George McFarlane at Nashwaakasis, and known as the McFarlane Wagon Works, and to purchase, take over or otherwise acquire and hold the property, both real and personal, used by the said George McFarlane in carrying on the said business, and to pay for the same with shares or stock of the Company or otherwise.

(b) To purchase, lease, buy, rent, hire or otherwise acquire and hold real and personal property of all kinds, and to sell, lease rent, hire or otherwise dispose of the same.

(c) To build, erect, equip, establish, maintain and operate buildings, houses, factories, warehouses and machine shops.

(d) To borrow money for the needs of the Company, and to mortgage, pledge or hypothecate any or all the assets of the Company, real or personal, as security for loans made to the Company.

(e) To purchase, take or in any way acquire and hold mortgages, liens, or other securities on real or personal property, including stocks or bonds of any incorporated company, as security for any indebtedness to the Company.
