The Company hereby incorporated shall be liable for the debts and obligations of the said William Ernest Benn, existing at the time of taking over the said property, and may be

sued for the same in any Court of competent jurisdiction; by the name of "The Benn Train Signal System Company, Limited," with a total capital stock of one hundred and ninety-nine thousand nine hundred dollars, divided into one thousand nine hundred and ninety-nine shares of one hundred dollars each, and with the head office at Saint Leonards, in the County of Madawaska, in said Province.
