NOTICE is hereby given, that within one month after the last publication of this notice in the Royal Gazette, application will be made to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent under the provisions of The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, being Chapter 85 of the Consolidated Statutes of New Brunswick, 1903, and amending Acts, constituting the persons hereinafter named and such other persons as may become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is "O. B. DAVIS COMPANY, LIMITED," which is not the name of any other known incorporated company or any name liable to be confounded therewith, or otherwise on public grounds objectionable.

2. The objects for which incorporation are sought are:

(a) To acquire by purchase or otherwise as a going concern the logging, lumber manufacturing and general trading and other business now and heretofore carried on by Oran B. Davis at the Parish of Drummond in the County of Victoria, including his lands, leases, licenses, mill property, mill machinery, logs, lumber manufactured and unmanufactured, logging contracts, merchandise, supplies and generally all his assets, rights and credits, and to carry on the same or any part thereof and to take over the liabilities of said business.

(b) To conduct a general logging and lumber manufacturing business and for that purpose to purchase, lease, acquire, develop and operate water powers, construct dams, mill races, flumes, sluices, booms, piers and other works in connection therewith.

(c) To construct, buy, erect, operate, maintain, own, sell and dispose of mills, planing mills and other structures for the manufacture of logs, lumber and lumber products, and to cut, haul, drive, manufacture, sell, barter and deal in logs, lumber, wood, pulpwood, pulp, paper, wood and wooden materials of all kinds and the byproducts thereof.

(d) To carry on a general manufacturing lumber and mining business including the buying and selling of timber

land and stumps, mines and mining rights, and to have, hold, sell, lease, let, hire, mortgage, hypothecate or dispose of real and personal estate of every nature, kind and description.

(e) To carry on the business of merchants, wholesale and retail, and general store-keepers and to deal in supplies and general merchandise.

(f) To carry on the business of railway contractors, and general construction work with all powers incidental or convenient thereto.

(g) To carry on the business of farming and dairying and dealers and breeders in live stock and fur bearing animals and to deal in farm produce.

(h) To issue fully paid up shares, bonds or debentures of the Company in payment or part payment of the purchase price of any property, real or personal, business or good will acquired by the Company, or in payment of any services rendered or work performed for the Company, or in purchase of the bonds, stock, property or assets of any other company having objects similar in whole or in part to those of the Company.

(i) To sell, lease, transfer or dispose of the whole or any part of the business, property or undertakings of the Company to any person, firm or corporation, and to accept and receive in lieu thereof the shares, bonds or debentures of any other company.

(j) To acquire and undertake the whole or any part of the business property and liabilities of any person or company carrying on or authorized to carry on any business similar in whole or in part to the business which this Company is authorized to carry on, or possessed of property suitable for the purposes of this Company, with power also to amalgamate with any such person or company.
