Dental Act, 1890," which reads as follows: "No person shall be entitled to recover any charges in any Court of Law for services as Dentist or Dental Surgeon, or for any medicines which he shall have both prescribed and supplied, unless he shall prove upon trial that at the time the services were performed or the medicines prescribed and supplied, he was registered under this Act."
