"O. B. DAVIS COMPANY, LIMITED."

NOTICE is hereby given, that within one month after the last publication of this notice in the Royal Gazette, application will be made to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent under the provisions of The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, being Chapter 85 of the Consolidated Statutes of New Brunswick, 1903, and amending Acts, constituting the persons hereinafter named and such other persons as may become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is "O. B. DAVIS COMPANY, LIMITED," which is not the name of any other known incorporated company or any name liable to be confounded therewith, or otherwise on public grounds objectionable.

2. The objects for which incorporation are sought are:

(a) To acquire by purchase or otherwise as a going concern the logging, lumber manufacturing and general trading and other business now and heretofore carried on by Oran B. Davis at the Parish of Drummond in the County of Victoria, including his lands, leases, licenses, mill property, mill machinery, logs, lumber manufactured and unmanufactured, logging contracts, merchandise, supplies and generally all his assets, rights and credits, and to carry on the same or any part thereof and to take over the liabilities of said business.

(b) To conduct a general logging and lumber manufacturing business and for that purpose to purchase, lease, acquire, develop and operate water powers, construct dams, mill races, flumes, sluices, booms, piers and other works in connection therewith.
