bountiful harvest and other blessings .---We, therefore, considering that these blessings enjoyed by Our people throughout the said Dominion do call for a public and solemn acknowledgment, have thought fit, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, to appoint. and We do hereby appoint Monday, the ninth day of October next, as a day of General Thanksgiving to Almighty God for the bountiful harvest and other blessings with which Canada has been favoured this year: and We do invite all our loving subjects throughout Canada to observe the said day as a day of General Thanksgiving.

Of all which Our loving subjects and all others whom these presents may concern, are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

In testimony whereof. We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. Witness, Our Most Dear and Entirely Beloved Uncle and Most Faithful Counsellor Field Marshal His Royal Highness Prince Arthur William Patrick Albert, Duke of Connaught and of Strathearn, Earl of Sussex (in the Peerage of the United Kingdom), Prince of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Duke of Saxony, Prince of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha; Knight of Our Most Noble Order of the Garter; Knight of Our Most
