

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that application will be made to the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick at the next session thereof for the passing of an Act to amend Chapter 76 of the Acts of Assembly 1915 in the following respects, namely: By providing that the amount that the Commissioners are authorized under Section 5 of the said Act to borrow and issue debentures therefor shall be increased from fifteen thousand dollars to twenty-four thousand dollars, with power to the said Commissioners to issue debentures for the said last mentioned sum of twenty-four thousand dollars without further authorization by any annual or special meeting of the ratepayers of the incorporated district; to amend Section 13 of the said Act by striking out the words "seventy five" in the second line thereof and substituting therefor the word "sixty"; to amend Section 17 of the said Act by striking out the word "ten" in the seventh line thereof and substituting therefor the word "twenty"; to fix the time and place of holding the first annual meeting of the ratepayers of the said district; and to ratify and confirm the proceedings of a special meeting of the ratepayers of The Richibucto and Rexton Electric Light District held at Richibucto, in the County of Kent, on the seventeenth day of December, A. D. 1915, and to amend Section 5 of the said Act by adding after the word "maintain" in the 13th line thereof the words "dams and reservoirs" and by striking out the words "thereof in and throughout places adjacent thereto in the said County of Kent" in the 18th and 19th lines of the said Section and substituting therefor the words "in and throughout any other portion of the said County of Kent."
