D. 1915, and to amend Section 5 of the said Act by adding after the word "maintain" in the 13th line thereof the words "dams and reservoirs" and by striking out the words "thereof in and throughout places adjacent thereto in the said County of Kent" in the 18th and 19th lines of the said Section and substituting therefor the words "in and throughout any other portion of the said County of Kent."
