the like fees to be paid as above.

On Bills for the Incorporation of Companies having a
stated capital, the same fee to be paid according to the
amount of capital authorized as are imposed under the N.
B. Joint Stock Companies Act, together with a fee for each
page of the Bill exceeding five, of \$10.00.

On Bills in amendment of such Acts, one-third of the
original fee, except when the capital is not increased nor
powers extended, in which cases the same fee shall be paid
as on Bills amending Acts for incorporating Companies not
having a stated capital.

A page, for the purposes of this Rule, shall mean, not
exceeding 500 words.

Provided, that where a Bill in respect of which such
payment has been made, does not pass the Legislature, it
may be introduced at the next following Session, upon the
payment of an additional sum of \$10.00; and

Provided, that where the Rule shall not extend to Acts
for the incorporation or relating to the property or objects of
churches, public halls, or societies for charitable, literary or
recreational purposes whose object is not private gain.

davit or solemn declaration.
