

Crown Land Office, July 25th, 1917.

NOTICE is hereby given to the holders of Timber Licenses in the Blue Bell Tract, County of Victoria, that the following stumpage rates will be in effect on and after the first of August, 1917, on all lumber cut in that Tract after that date, namely.

For Spruce, Pine or Hachmatac saw logs, per M superficial feet	\$4.00
Hardwood Timber, up to an average of 14 in. sq. per ton	2.50
Hardwood Timber, above 14 inches, additional per inch per ton	.25
Hardwood logs, per M. superficial feet	2.75
Pine Timber up to 14 inches square, per ton	2.75
Pine Timber, additional per inch per ton	.75
Hachmatac Timber, per ton	1.50
Spruce Timber, per ton	1.75
Cedar Logs, per M	4.00
Railway Ties, 8 feet length, each	.15
Hemlock Logs, per M. superficial feet, including bark	3.00
White Birch, for spool wood, per cord	1.50
White Birch Logs, for spool wood, per M. sup. feet	3.00
Fir Logs, per M. superficial feet	3.00
Poplar Logs, per M. superficial feet	2.50

And for all other descriptions of lumber not specified

above, 15 per cent. of the market value thereof at the mill, place of shipment, or place of consumption in the Province.

That all previous Orders-in-Council affecting the licenses in the Blue Bell Tract are rescinded and that all leases conveying the right to cut and carry away lumber in the said Tract be for the term of one year only from the first day of August in any year and the General Timber Regulations passed by Order-in-Council the 11th day of July, 1917, govern the operations of the timber lands in the Blue Bell Tract in all respects except those relating to the period of the lease and the rates of stumpage.
