BRIDGE NOTICE.

SEALED TENDERS marked "Tender for Florenceville Bridge Superstructure," will be received at the Department of Public Works, Fredericton, until Wednesday, 4th day of July, 1917, at noon, for constructing one new steel span of 56 feet in the clear length, along with the repositioning of the present superstructures from their present positions on the old crib works to that of the to be constructed new concrete piers and abutments, according to plans and specifications to be seen at the Public Works Department, Fredericton, N. B.

Each tender must be accompanied by a certified bank cheque or Cash for an amount equal to five per cent. of a grand total amount, made up as follows: 100,000 lbs. of metal superstructure at the tendered rate per lb., plus the tendered lump sum for the roadway floor construction, embracing reinforced concrete base for wagon roadway with its creosoted wood block wearing surface and all concrete side curbs appertaining to such floor system; plus the tendered lump sum for repositioning of present superstructures. Such certified bank cheque or cash will be returned to the parties whose tenders are not accepted, but with the party to whom the contract is awarded, it shall be retained until the final completion of the contract and its acceptance by the Department. Not obliged to accept the lowest or any tender.
