## NOTICE OF GRANTING SUPPLEMENTARY LETTERS PATENT

## NASHWAAK PULP AND PAPER COMPANY, LIMITED.

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given, that under the New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916, and amending Acts, Supplementary Letters Patent under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer have been issued dated the twenty-first day of November, A. D. 1917, whereby the capital stock of the Company be and the same is hereby increased by the creation of 17,000 shares of preference stock of the par value of \$100 each, making a total increase of capital of \$1,700,000 over and above the fifteen thousand shares without nominal or par value now outstanding. Said preference shares are divided into two series, amounting in the aggregate to 17,000 shares, designated Series A and Series B, but all ranking equally and with equal rights and preferences. Each of said series are comprised of 8,500 and are all of the par value of \$100 each, and are by the Letters Patent and by the by-laws of the Company constituted "preference shares." Said preference shares shall confer on the holder thereof the right to a fixed preferential cumulative dividend payable out of the net earnings of the Company at the rate of six per centum per annum upon the par value of said shares upon the first days of May and November of each year, commencing on the first day of May, A. D. 1918, before any dividend for such dividend period shall be declared or paid upon the common shares of the Company; and the further right and priority on a winding up to a return of capital to the par value of said preference shares and a payment off of said preferential dividends whether declared or not, up to the commencement of the winding up over all other shares in the capital of the Company for the time being, but does not confer any rights to participate further in the profits or assets of the Company.
