To act as brokers or agents for any firm or corporation selling, handling or manufacturing any machinery or such like articles.

To borrow money upon the credit of the Company, or any of its property or assets.

To do all or anything incidentally in connection with or conducive to the objects, purpose and powers hereinbefore set forth, or any of them; which may be considered by the Company to be advisable or necessary in carrying on the business of the Company, or in exercising the powers hereinbefore mentioned, or any of them; under the name of "Syndicat d'Anderson Limitee," with a total capital stock of twenty thousand dollars, divided into two hundred shares of one hundred dollars each and with the head office at Anderson, in the Parish of Grimmer, in the County of Restigouche and Province of New Brunswick.

NOTICE.

NOTICE is hereby given to all residents, non-residents, and corporations, whether within or without the Province, in compliance with "An Act respecting the taxation of wild lands" passed 11th April, 1918, to file with the Minister of Lands and Mines at the Crown Land Office in Fredericton on or before the first of July 1918, a statement of the number of acres subject to the tax as provided by the Act; Parishes where the land is situated; what fractional part of the interest in said lands is held by resident and by non-resident owners, or if owned by a corporation what fractional part of the stock is held by resident and by non-resident stockholders and the name and address of the manager, managing owner or managing director of said land.

Upon failure to comply with this demand an additional tax of one cent per acre may be imposed not exceeding in the whole the sum of \$30 in addition to the tax as prescribed by the Act.

Taxes are payable at the Crown Land Office in Fredericton on or before the first of September, 1918, and remittances can be forwarded in the name of T. G. Loggie, Deputy Minister of Lands and Mines.
