BRIDGE NOTICE.

SEALD TENDERS marked "Tender for Nerepis River (Mouth) Bridge Metal Superstructure" will be received at the Department of Public Works, Fredericton, until Wednesday, the 11th day of December, 1918, at 5 o'clock p. m., for constructing the Metal Superstructure of Nerepis River (Mouth) Bridge, Parish of Westfield, Kings county, N. B., consisting of the following:

- One through fixed riveted span of 70 ft., 10 in., in the clear.
- One through fixed riveted span of 47 ft., 2 in., in the clear.
- One through fixed riveted span of 55 ft., 4 in., in the clear.

One through fixed riveted span of 45 ft., 11 in., in the clear. According to plans and specifications to be seen at the Public Works Department, Fredericton, N. B.

Each tender must be accompanied by a certified bank cheque or cash for an amount equal to five per cent. of the total amount of the tender, which will be forfeited if the party tendering declines to enter into contract when called upon. Such certified bank cheque or cash will be returned to the parties whose tenders are not accepted, but with the party to whom the contract is awarded, it shall be retained until the final completion of the contract and its acceptance by the Department. Not obliged to accept lowest or any tender.
