LETTERS PATENT GRANTED**BONNY RIVER LUMBER COMPANY, LIMITED.**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, that under the New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916, and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer bearing date the thirty-first day of December, A. D. 1918, incorporating Arthur Jerome O'Connor, Lumberman; William Edgar Golding, Merchant; and George Robert McKean, Merchant, all of the City of Saint John, in the City and County of Saint John, and Province of New Brunswick, for the following purposes, namely:

To construct, erect, establish or otherwise acquire, own, maintain and operate mills and factories for the manufacture of timber, lumber, pulp wood and any and all article capable of being manufactured from the products of the forest, and to buy, sell and deal in timber, lumber, pulp wood and products of the forest generally, and all articles manufactured therefrom or in connection therewith, and to do all matters and things necessary or incidental to the carrying on of the business of lumbering in all its branches.
