

LETTERS PATENT GRANTED

ST. JOHN GARAGE & SUPPLY COMPANY, LIMITED.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under the New Brunswick Companies Act, 1916, and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the twenty-first day of September, A. D. 1920, incorporating Frederick D. Ryan, Mechanic; Lloyd C. Ryan, Sales Agent; both of the City of Saint John, in the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick, and Mary Elizabeth Ryan, Unmarried Woman, of the City of Fredericton, in the County of York and Province aforesaid, for the following purposes, namely:

To acquire from the said Frederick D. Ryan and Lloyd C. Ryan the business now carried on by them as a dealer in automobiles and automobile accessories, equipment and appliances and as a repairer of automobiles including all the assets, rights and credits of the said business and the good will thereof.

To buy, sell, trade in and carry on the business of dealers in automobiles, cycles, bicycles, tricycles, motors, engines, carriages, aeroplanes, hydroplanes and conveyances of all kinds and in all articles used in the construction thereof, and all fuels, lubricants, accessories, tools, equipment and appliances used in connection therewith.

To carry on the business of machinists.

To apply for, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire any patents, licenses, concessions or the like conferring exclusive or limited right to use any invention which may seem capable of being used for any of the purposes of the Company, and to use, exercise, lease, sell or grant licenses in respect thereof or otherwise turn to account the property or rights so to be acquired.

To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or in any other manner and to hold real estate, lands and premises and rights and interests in real estate, lands and premises and water rights and privileges, and to build upon, work, operate, develop and otherwise improve, utilize and turn to account the same.

TREASURE ISLANDS, SEA FISHING, SHOOTING AND SPORTING CLUB, LIMITED.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916," and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the twenty-third day of September, A. D. 1920, incorporating John E. Moore, Lumber Merchant; Lewden Robert Ross, Railway Official, and George McAvity, Manufacturer, all of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick, for the following purposes, namely:

To purchase, take in exchange or otherwise acquire lands, buildings, easements and property of any kind either real or personal, and especially certain lands and premises situated, lying and being in the Parish of Lepreaux, in the County of Charlotte, consisting of two islands known as the Two Brothers, and certain other lands and premises situated in said Parish, conveyed by one Frederick Ellis and wife to the said Lewden R. Ross by deed dated the twentieth day of July, A. D. 1920.

To promote, organize, conduct and manage a fishing, shooting and social club and to promote the welfare of the members thereof, with power to make and adopt a constitution and by-laws, rules and regulations for admission, suspension and expulsion of its members and for their government, and for the collection of fees and dues, for the election and appointment of its directors and other officers and to define their duties, and for the safekeeping and protection of its property and funds and in general to regulate, manage and preserve its property and interests, and from time to time to alter, repeal, rescind or vary such constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations, or any of them.

To enter into any arrangements with any authorities, municipal, local or otherwise, that may seem conducive to the Company's objects or any of them, and to obtain from any such authority, rights, privileges and concessions which the corporate company may think desirable, to obtain and to carry out,
