Where the cost value does not exceed \$1,000.....	a fee of \$10.00
Over \$1,000.00 and under \$2,000.00	" " " 15.00
Over \$2,000.00 and under \$3,000.00	" " " 20.00
Over \$3,000.00 and under \$4,000.00	" " " 25.00
Over \$4,000.00 and under \$5,000.00	" " " 30.00
Over \$5,000.00 and under \$6,000.00	" " " 35.00

And for \$5,000.00 and upwards the same fee shall be charged as for trading companies. Also that the fee for one insertion in the Royal Gazette of the notice of granting letters patent shall be \$2.25 per square.
