LETTERS PATENT GRANTED

ACADIA PRODUCTS, LIMITED.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916," and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the third day of December, A. D. 1920, incorporating William Bliss Fawcett, Farmer; Frank William Cole, Broker; both of Sackville, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick; James Herbert Morey, Farmer; of Penobscia, in the County of Kings and Province aforesaid; Albert Roy Fawcett, Farmer, and Frank Wilfred Wry, Agent, both of Sackville, in the County of Westmorland and Province aforesaid, for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on the business of growing, raising, producing, buying, selling, treating, preserving, pickling, drying, smoking, canning, marketing and in other mode or manner and by any means, device or process, dealing in, or in any respects utilizing, fruits, berries, wild or cultivated, horticultural products, vegetables, garden and agricultural products, meats, animal, fish, dairy and other food products, of every nature and kind, and any products and by-products thereof.

To manufacture or otherwise deal in jams, condiments, marmalades, jellies, syrups, preserves, mince meats, pickles, relishes, extracts and all other grocer's sundries and supplies.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, timber lands, woodlands or other lands or rights, licenses or interests therein, or in respect of any timber or trees growing thereon, and to re-forest, afforest or in any other manner to develop the same.

To carry on the business of lumbering and the lumber trade

in all its branches, including buying, selling, dealing in and manufacturing all kinds of sawed, squared and hewed lumber and timber, saw logs, ties, piling, poles, posts, wood and all other products of the forest.

To carry on in all its branches, the business of a manufacturer and dealer in timber, pulp, pulp wood, paper and other products or by-products of wood, and all other articles and materials in which wood, lumber, pulp, pulp wood or paper enter or form part.

To carry on the business of general manufacturers and millers.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire mines, seams or deposits of coal, or rights or interests therein, or in respect thereof, and to explore, work, get, develop, sell, market and in any manner turn the same to account.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire mines, beds, pits or deposits of clay of all kinds and to mine, get, work, develop, sell, market or otherwise turn the same to account.

To carry on the business of manufacturing brick, tile, pipe and all other clay products.

To manufacture, buy, sell or otherwise deal in boxes, crates, tins, cans, jars, containers, barrels, packages and other receptacles useful or convenient in connection with the handling, packing, transportation and preparation of any goods, wares or products in which the Company is authorized to deal.

To carry on the business of a grower, shipper, exporter, importer and dealer in seeds, farm, garden, agricultural, fish and dairy produce and all other food products and all other products in which the Company is authorized to deal.

To establish shops, stores, agencies, depots and other markets for the sale of the products of the Company, or in which it is authorized to deal.

To build, construct, purchase, lease, acquire, maintain, conduct and operate plants, buildings, factories, mills, machinery, shops, stores, warehouses and other establishments for manufacturing, canning, preparing, selling, exposing for sale, storing, generating or in any other manner whatsoever, treating, modifying or dealing with any substance, thing, commodity or product in which the Company may deal, or any thing, article, device, power, energy, composition, preparation, material or substance which may be used as incidental to, or in connection with any part of the authorized business or undertaking of the Company, or otherwise, howsoever, for carrying out the objects and purposes of the Company.

To build, acquire, purchase, conduct, maintain, use and operate, and to carry on the business of cold and dry storage and refrigerator plants, cars, conveyances and establishments.

To carry on the business of buying, raising, producing, selling or otherwise dealing in cattle, horses, sheep, swine, poultry, lobsters, oysters, shell fish, fish and all other animals or products of the sea.
