

LETTERS PATENT GRANTED

SUTHERLAND BROS., LIMITED

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916" and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Seventeenth day of May, A. D., 1921, incorporating Roderick Henry Sutherland, Merchant; Daniel Hugh Sutherland, Merchant; and Alfred Edmund Lord, Clerk; all of the City of Moncton, County of Westmorland, and Province of New Brunswick for the following purposes namely:

To carry on the business of wholesale and retail grocers, grain and provision merchants, in all branches, and the business of importing and exporting all products used or dealt with in any such business.

To purchase, import, export, prepare, manufacture, and sell, groceries, food stuffs, and other wares and merchandise connected with any such business.

To act as commercial and commission agents for the sale and purchase of such products.

To manufacture, produce, sell and in any manner to deal in hardware.

To manufacture, produce, adapt, prepare, lease, buy and to sell or otherwise dispose of or deal in, iron and steel products, machines, machinery, and any articles in the manufacture or composition of which metal is a factor, and to carry on any other manufacturing or distributing business which can conveniently be carried on in conjunction with any of the Company's purposes or objects.

To carry on the respective businesses of plumbing, manufacturing, contractors for plumbing and sanitary fixtures and supplies, heating and ventilating plant and supplies, pipes, fittings, apparatus and repairs for heat, light, gas or water supplies.

To carry on the business of tinmiths and metal workers and dealers in all sundries and supplies used or employed in respect thereof.

To carry on the business of dealers in builders and contractors supplies of every kind, and in particular but not so as to restrict the generality of the foregoing, in every manner to deal in lumber, concrete, cement, bricks, asphalt, sheet metal, roof preparations, city products, gravel, sand, stone, lime, limestone, plaster, tile, blocks, sewer pipes, water pipes and all other materials and supplies which can be used directly or indirectly therewith.

To sell, dispose of or otherwise howsoever deal with any property, substance, power, material, commodity, article or thing which is not required for the purposes of the Company.

To procure the Company to be registered, licensed or otherwise recognized in any other Province of Canada, or in any foreign Country and to designate and appoint persons therein, as attorneys or representatives of the company with full power to represent it in all manner according to the laws of such Province or foreign country and to accept service for or on behalf of the Company of any process or suit.

To issue and allot as fully or partly paid up shares of the Company in payment or in part payment of any property, immovable or movable, rights, leases, franchises, undertakings, powers, privileges, licenses, concessions, stocks, shares, bonds, debentures, debenture stocks, or other property which the company is authorized to acquire and hold.

To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any of the assets, business, property, privileges, contracts, rights, obligations and liabilities of any company, partnership, association or person carrying on any part of the business which the Company is authorized to carry on, or possessed of property suitable for the purposes of the Company; and to pay for the same in cash or in shares of the Company, or partly in cash and partly in shares.

To distribute the whole or any part of the property or assets of the Company in specie or money among its shareholders; provided however, that no such distribution shall effect a reduction of the capital of the Company, except made in accordance with the New Brunswick Companies' Act 1916.

To pay all costs, charges and expenses incurred or sustained in or about the promotion or establishment of the Company, or which the Company shall consider preliminary.

To take or otherwise acquire and hold shares in any other company having

objects altogether or in part similar to those of the Company or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the Company.

The powers in each paragraph hereof, shall be in nowise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraph: By the name of Sutherland Bros. Limited, with a capital stock of Seventy-five thousand dollars divided into seven hundred and fifty shares of one hundred dollars, of which Forty-five thousand dollars shall be common stock, and \$30,000 shall be preferred stock. The holders of preferred stock shall be entitled to a cumulative dividend in each year of an amount equal to seven per centum upon the amount actually paid in on such stock, payable from profits, if earned; and such shares both as to dividends and as to the distributive share of the assets on the dissolution or winding up of the Company shall have preference over any other stock at any time issued. No dividend shall be paid on Common stock in and for any year until seven per centum shall have been declared and paid in for that year upon the preferred stock, with the head office at the City of Moncton in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick.
