To deal in, buy, sell and contract for the supply of, and to supply all sorts of appliances and devices, machines and machinery with their accessories dealing with or appertaining to the prevention of fire.

To act as agents or attorneys for the management of estates, the sale of property, the investment, handling, loan, payment, transmission and collection of moneys, rents, interests, dividends, mortgages, bonds, debentures and other securities, and the undertaking of investigations, valuations, sales, exchanges, leases, subdivisions and the like, and to carry on the business of general brokers and agents.

To transact or carry on all kinds of financial agency business, and in particular in relation to the investment of money the sale or property and the collection and receipt of money.

To carry on the business of agents for loan, mortgage, trust and investment companies and all branches and departments thereof.

To transact all kinds of agency business.

To negotiate loans, to find investments, to carry on business as capitalists, financiers, valuers, holding agents, brokers and manufacturers agents.

To purchase or otherwise acquire, sell dispose of or otherwise deal in real and personal property of all kinds and in particular in lands, fuel, lumber, wood products, shares, stocks, bonds, debentures, securities, book debts and any interest in real or personal property and any claim against such property or against any person or company.

To advance money on the security of any kind of real or personal property.

To buy, sell and deal in warrants, bonds, debentures, bills of lading, warehouse receipts, choses in action, coupons and other negotiable or transferrable or non-negotiable securities or documents.

To subscribe for, underwrite, issue on commission or otherwise take hold and deal in shares and securities of all kinds.
