eal Division of the Experimental Farms Branch, Ottawa. The samples will consist of spring wheat (about 5 lbs.), white oats (about 4 lbs.), barley (about 5 lbs.), field peas (not garden peas—about 5 lbs.), field beans (about 2 lbs.), flax for seed and flax for fibre (about 2 lbs.)

Application must be made on a printed form which will be supplied by the Cereal Division, Central Experimental Farm, Ottawa. (No postage is required on letters so admessed). No application forms will be supplied after February 15th, 1923. Farmers are advised to send at once for forms in order not to be at once for forms in order not to be disappointed, as in some cases the stock is limited. The allotment of samples will be made in order of application. Only one sample will be sent to a farm.
