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PROCLAMATION



By His Honour William Pugsley, D.C.L., LL.D., K.C., P.C., Lieutenant-Governor of the Province of New Brunswick.

WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday, the Eleventh day of May A.D. 1922 I have thought fit further to prorogue the said Legislative Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued accordingly, to Thursday the Twentieth day of June next.

BY HIS HONOUR THE HONOURABLE WILLIAM PUGSLEY, D.C.L., LL.D., K.C., P.C., LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF THE PROVINCE OF NEW BRUNSWICK:

WILLIAM PUGSLEY

Whereas, the forests of the Province of New Brunswick constitute one of our greatest natural resources and as such are an asset of tremendous value and importance. They are essential to the prosperity and welfare of our Province and its people.

And Whereas, the people of New Brunswick, individually and acting through their governmental agency and for protective associations, have long endeavored to secure adequate protection of the forests from fire, the most destructive agency that threatens our woodlands.

Realizing that a more earnest and concerted effort is imperative if we are to safeguard our heritage, I do therefore under the provisions of Section 45 of the "Forest Fires Act", 1918 as amended by Chapter 22 of the Acts of Assembly 12 George V., 1922, Proclaim the week beginning Tuesday the Twenty-third day of May, 1922 as

Forest Fire Protection Week

and I do call upon all citizens to observe said week and to spread broadcast the word of caution regarding forest fires; and upon clergymen, teachers, boards of trade and all public officials, societies and associations to exert themselves to the utmost to inform those with whom they come in contact, of the transcendent importance of our forests and of the need for their adequate protection from fire.
