There will be offered for sale in one block at public auction in front of the Sunbury County Record office, Oromocto, in the Parish of Burton, in the Province of New Brunswick, wherein the property is situated, a certain lot of lands and premises, recently in suit before the Supreme Court, Chancery Division, in an action between James W. Crawford, plaintiff and Letitia Jane Short, et al, defendants.

A decree having issued out of the Court for partition the public auction of the property in question pursuant to said decree will be held as above on Thursday 27th day of July 1922 at the hour of one o'clock in the afternoon. Said lands and premises are in the Plaintiffs statement of claim and in the said decree mentioned and described as follows, namely:
