To manufacture, buy, sell, and deal in

peat, wood and alcohol, calcium carbide, and all kinds of chemicals, and to purchase, erect or otherwise acquire such factories and works as may be deemed necessary for such purchase.

To manufacture, import and sell goods, wares and merchandise and generally to carry on a woodworking and manufacturing business and all things in connection therewith and incidental thereto.

To purchase, lease, acquire and to have and hold real and personal estate of all kinds, including bonds and stock of any incorporated company, and to take, acquire, have and hold security upon any real or personal property or effects whatsoever.
