

To carry on the business of buying and selling fish or meat of every nature and kind; the canning of fish or preserving and curing the same by smoking, salting or freezing or otherwise as it may see fit.

To carry on all products of the fish or meat business.

To purchase, manufacture, buy, acquire, advertise, sell and deal in fish and meat products of every nature and kind, and all other articles and materials incidental to the carrying on of the said business.

To buy, sell and lease lands, buildings and other property either real or personal in connection with or for the purposes of the Company's business.
