Over \$2,000.00 and under \$3,000.00 a fee
of \$20.00.

Over \$3,000.00 and under \$4,000.00 a fee
of \$25.00.

Over \$4,000.00 and under \$5,000.00 a fee
of \$30.00.

And for \$5,000.00 and upwards the
same fee shall be charged as for trading
companies. Also that the fee for one in-
sertion in the Royal Gazette of the notice
of granting letters patent shall be \$2.50
per square.
