

NEW TIMBER APPLICATIONS

Licenses to expire on the first of August 1924, but subject to renewal to 1st August 1925, in accordance with Chapter XL. 3 George V., 1912, for Saw Mill Licenses of the following applications for Timber Berths, for the purpose of cutting all classes of lumber, will be sold at this office on Thursday the 3rd day of January 1924 at noon.

Upset price \$20 per square mile in addition to stumpage.

There is no payment of any bonus required. Licenses are renewable each year by payment of \$8 per square mile, and fire tax of \$3.20 per square mile. Stumpage in accordance with the regulations in force and subject to annual change.

All timber, logs, or other lumber cut upon unlicensed Crown Land or which may be cut by any person beyond the limits of his own berth, shall be seized and forfeited to the use of the Crown; and no Timber or Lumber shall be cut on any berth applied for until it shall be purchased at public auction.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies Act, 1916", and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Tenth day of December, A. D. 1923, incorporating Peter J. Nordby, Manufacturer; G. B. Wetmore, Manufacturer; and R. Dwight Mitton, Barrister-at-Law; all of the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To acquire and take over as a going concern the business now carried on at the said City of Moncton by the said Peter J. Nordby and G. B. Wetmore as a partnership under the firm name and style of Nordby & Wetmore, and all the assets and liabilities of the said business; so carried on by the said Peter J. Nordby and G. B. Wetmore and the rights and contracts now held by them in connection with the said business, subject to the obligations, if any, affecting the same, and to pay for the same in part in fully paid-up shares in the Company and in part in cash as hereinafter set forth.

To acquire, own and carry on the business of wholesale and retail dealers in and purchasers and manufacturers of furniture, antiques and novelties of all kinds.

To construct or otherwise acquire, operate, control, manage and deal in mills or machinery, machine shops, factories, works, appliances and equipment of every description for the transportation, handling, manufacture and finishing of lumber and of any manufacture of wood or lumber or wood and any other materials severally and in combination and of all products of wood or other materials whatsoever, and in the manufacture and repair of furniture of all kinds.

To engage in, conduct and carry on any other business whether manufacturing or otherwise which may seem to the Company capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with its business or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable

any of the Company's property or rights.

To apply for, purchase or otherwise acquire any patents, licenses, concessions and the like, conferring any exclusive or non-exclusive, or limited rights to use or any secret or other information as to any inventions which may seem capable of being used for any of the purposes of the Company, or the acquisition of which may seem capable of being used for any of the purposes of the Company, or the acquisition of which may seem calculated directly or indirectly to benefit the Company, and to use, exercise, develop or grant licenses in respect of, or otherwise turn to account the property rights or information so acquired.
