Letters Patent Granted

"NEW BRUNSWICK PUBLISHING COMPANY, LIMITED".

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916," and amending Acts, Supplementary Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the 26th. day of September, A. D. 1923, whereby the Capital Stock of "New Brunswick Publishing Company, Limited", has been increased from \$600,000 to \$700,000, by the creation of 1,000 Preference Shares of \$100.00 each, said 1,000 Preference Shares to be Second Preferred Shares and shall be subject to the rights and priorities of the Preference Shares created by the Charter of the Company, but shall confer upon the holder a right to a cumulative preferential dividend at the rate of Eight Per Centum per Annum, and in addition thereto shall participate in dividends with the common shares of the Company, and shall, upon the winding up of the Company, have priority as to return of capital and the payment of all arrears of dividend, whether declared or not, and shall further have priority as to the return of capital over the Common Shares of the Capital Stock for the time being of the Company upon such winding up, dissolution, bankruptcy or otherwise, and the said Preference Shares shall be subject to the right of the Company to redeem the same upon payment to the owner or owners thereof of the sum of \$110.00 per share for each and every share.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916," and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the First day of October, A. D. 1923, incorporating Julius T. Whitlock, Insurance Agent; of the Town of Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte and Province of New Brunswick; C. Campbell Whitlock, Merchant; of the City of Calais, in the County of Washington and State of Maine; and Oscar E. Whitlock, Jeweller; of the Town of Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte and Province of New Brunswick, for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on the business of a local insurance agent and as such to negotiate solicit and write, fire, life and accident

and all or any other forms of insurance for any Insurance Company or Companies, having a legal right to do business in the Province of New Brunswick and from time to time to renew, continue or extend such insurance when effected and to collect premiums and renewal premiums for such insurance.

To adjust, appraise, settle and compromise any and all losses that may occur under any fire Insurance policy or policies.

To adjust, appraise, settle and compromise any and all claims that may arise under any life, accident or other form of Insurance policy or policies, whether through death, accident, sickness or otherwise howsoever.

Generally to do and perform all things needful or necessary to be done in connection with a general local Insurance agency to all intents and purposes and as fully and effectually in every respect as such needful or necessary purposes might or could be done by an individual.

To buy, sell, convey, mortgage, lease, hypothecate or otherwise encumber any real estate in any part of the Province of New Brunswick, as a real Estate Broker, either on retainer, commission or other lawful basis whatever.

To buy and sell and convey real estate for profit or on margin.

To secure loans for others and negotiate and arrange for real estate or other forms of security to the lender.

To lease, sublease and re-lease and all forms of real estate, buildings, houses, mills, factories, shops, dwellings, and all tenements and hereditaments whatsoever within the Province of New Brunswick.

To buy, sell, and generally to deal in Bonds, Stocks and all forms of security for money and all authorized investments that are usually listed on the stock exchanges in the Dominion of Canada.

To solicit passengers for steamboat, railway and other transportation companies and to arrange for, secure, buy, sell and transfer to customers to be obtained for such transportation companies, tickets for transportation and other reservations and accommodation upon and with such transportation companies and otherwise to deal generally as an Agent for any and all transportation companies as have a legal right to do business in the Province of New Brunswick, and generally to do and perform all things needful, necessary or advantageous to be done in as a transportation, travelling or freight agent for a transportation company or companies as fully and effectively in every respect as might or could be done by an individual.

And generally to do and perform all lawful acts and things that may or can be done by a general Insurance, Real Estate, Stocks and Bonds Broker, Traffic and Freight and Manufacturer's Agent or that may come within the authority or rights of a general Commissioner, Agent or Broker within the Province of New
