

"RESTIGOUCHE COUNTRY CLUB"

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under the New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916, and Amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Sixth day of July, A. D. 1923 incorporating Maxwell M. Mowatt, Fishery Officer; W. Fraser Napier, Lumberman; and Hugh A. Carr, Barrister-at-Law; all of the Town of Campbellton, in the County of Restigouche and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To promote, organize, conduct and manage, golf, athletic country and social clubs, and to promote the welfare of the members thereof.

To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise, farm lands, lots and generally real estate of any description or any interest or rights therein, and to take build upon, hold, own, maintain, work, develop, lease and exchange or otherwise deal in and dispose of such lots, lands real estate and any interest therein.

To adopt a constitution and bye-laws rules and regulations for the admission and expulsion of the members of any golf, country or social club promoted, organized, conducted or managed by the Company, and for the government of said members and for the establishment of different classes of membership, for the collection of fees and dues for the election and appointment of directors and officers, and to define their duties and for the safekeeping and protection of its property and funds, and in general to regulate, manage and to preserve its property and interests, and from time to time to alter, repeal, rescind, or vary such constitution, bye-laws or regulations, or any of them.

To carry on any other business of the same or a similar nature, which may seem to the corporation capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with its business or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the corporations property or rights.

To enter into any arrangements with any authorities, municipal, local or otherwise, that may seem conducive to the corporations objects or any of them, and to obtain from any such authority any rights, privileges and concessions which the corporation may think it desirable to obtain and to carry out, exercise and comply with any such arrangements, rights, privileges and concessions.

To do such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects, by the name of "Restigouche Country Club", with a capital stock of Nine thousand nine hundred dollars divided into three hundred and ninety-six shares of Twenty-five dollars each, with the Head office at the Town of Campbellton, in the County of Restigouche and Province of New Brunswick.
