Notice is hereby given, that application will be made to the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick, at the next session thereof, for the passing of an Act, authorizing the Town of Bathurst to make an issue of debentures in a sum not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, for the purpose of installing fire alarm system, water meters and other necessary permanent works of the Town: Such debentures to be for \$500. each, and to be payable twenty years after date, and to bear interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent, payable semi-annually.

## NOTICE OF LEGISLATION

Notice is hereby given, that application will be made to the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick, at the next session thereof, for the passing of an Act, authorizing the Town Council, of the Town of Bathurst, from time to time, to define areas, within the Town limits, by by-law, wherein, on the passing of such by-laws, warehouses, store-houses, public and other buildings shall not be erected or built of materials other than stone, brick, or other non-combustible materials, with roofing of slate, tile, gravel, metal or other non-combustible material, and that all exterior walls thereof directly adjacent to other buildings shall rise, at least twelve inches above the roof. And for authority to the said Town Council to enact a by-law requiring a permit to be had from the Town or its duly authorized officer, before any building can be erected in the Town limits, and that permits shall only be given for erection of buildings which are permitted or are in accordance with the laws or by-laws.
