

FIRE PERMITS FOR BRUSH BURNING

In accordance with the regulations of the Forest Fires Act, notice is hereby given that no slash, stump piles, or brush burning will be permitted in the spring or summer. Fire permits will only be issued in the Fall when conditions are safe and only after debris has been piled in piles at least 50 feet from the Forest. Burning cannot be done unless under the supervision of a Fire Warden.
