The area for which the Scheme has been prepared includes land within the limits of the City of St. John, which is not already fully occupied for building purposes, also portions of the Parishes of Lancaster and Symonds in the County of St. John, within a radius varying from three to five miles approximately from the centre of the City, as delineated by boundary lines shown on the Map which accompanies the Scheme.

The aforesaid Town Planning Scheme and Map will be open for inspection by any person interested therein or affected thereby at the office of the City Engineer at the City Hall, Prince William Street, St. John, upon any week-day between the hours of ten and twelve in the forenoon, during the four weeks next ensuing, and the Common Council will, before submitting the said Scheme to the Governor in Council for approval, be

prepared to consider any objections or representations which may be made to them in writing during the aforesaid term of four weeks, by any persons affected thereby, including any persons representing any architectural, historical or other society interested in the amenity of the proposed Scheme.
