PROCLAMATION

In accordance with the authority given me under Section 43 of Chapter 29, 12 George V., 1922, all the forest land in the Province of New Brunswick is hereby proclaimed "a protected area" in accordance with the following regula-tions, namefy: tions, namely:

tions, namely: No person may enter upon any for-est land after May 1st., 1923 until No-vember 1st., 1923 for the purpose of travelling, camping or fishing, or plo-nicing or for other purposes, without first having registered with a local fire warden.
