Licenses to expire on the first of August 1923 but subject to renewal to 1st August 1923, in accordance with Chapter XI, 3 George V. 1913, for Saw Mill Licenses of the following applications for Timber Berths, for the purpose of cutting all classes of lumber, will be sold at this office on Thursday the 26th day of April 1923, at noon.

Upset price \$20 per square mile in addition to stumping.

There is no payment of any bonus required. Licenses are renewable each year by payment of \$8 per square mile and fire tax of \$3.20 per square mile. Stumping in accordance with the regulations in force and subject to annual change.
