HIS HONOUR THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR has been pleased to approve of the following bye-laws:

"By-law regulating the uses of the reads in Wilmot Park, in the City of of Fredericton.

Whereas, "The Wilmot Park Board' by virtue of an Act of the Legislative As-sembly of New Brunswick, being Chapter 55 of 58 Victoria (1895), is authorized and empowered to make by-laws and regulations, as they may deem proper, in order to carry into execution and enforce the powers vested in the said Board, to be in force only within and in respect to the said Wilmot Park;

Be it therefore enacted as a by-law of the said Wilmot Park Board as follows:

1. No person having charge of any horse or any horse and carriage, or of any motor vehicle, shall ride or drive the same within the said Park, faster than a rate of speed of eight miles an hour.
