Letters Patent Granted

"EMERY'S LIMITED"

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916," and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Twenty-ninth day of August, A. D. 1924, incorporating Alban Schofield Emery, Cabinet Maker, James Frederick Emery, Cabinet Maker, and Florence M. Emery, Stenographer, all of the City of St. John in the City and County of St. John, in the Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To manufacture, purchase, sell, and otherwise deal in furniture, musical instruments and all other products of a similar nature either directly or indirectly through the medium of agents or otherwise.

To carry on the business of cabinet-makers, carpenters, drawers, wood-workers and manufacturers of produce of wood products.

To buy, sell and deal in lumber and to operate saw-mills, planing mills, wood-working factories and furniture manufacturers.

To carry on the business of lumber merchant, saw and planing miller and manufacturer of lumber and wooden ware and to buy, let, own, sell and deal in timber lands and logs and to manufacture, buy, sell and deal in timber, lumber and wood of all kinds and to manufacture articles in the making of which timber or wood is required or can be utilized.

To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any of the assets, busi-

ness, property, privileges, contracts, rights, obligations, and liabilities of any company, society, partnership, or person carrying on any part of the business which this company is authorized to carry on or possessed of property suitable for the purposes of this company and to pay for the same in cash or in shares of this company or partly in cash and partly in cash and partly in shares and to consolidate or amalgamate with any other company having objects similar to those of this company in whole or in part.

To carry on any other business whether manufacturing or otherwise capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with its business or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the Company's property or rights.

To acquire, hold, mortgage, sell, and convey any real estate requisite for the carrying on of the undertakings of the company.

To exercise its corporate capacity in any part of the world.

To buy, sell, mortgage, transfer, hypothecate, and otherwise deal in shares of the capital stock of the company.

To do all or any of the above things and all things authorized by the letters patent as principals, agents, contractors, trustees or otherwise and either alone or in conjunction with others and to do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects; by the name of "Emery's Limited" with a capital stock of five thousand dollars, divided into fifty shares of one hundred dollars each, with the head office at the City of St. John, in the City and County of St. John in the Province of New Brunswick.

D. 1924, incorporating L. Edward Whittaker, Manufacturer's Agent, James E. Gorham, Salesman, and James B. Dever, Barrister-at-Law, all of the City of Saint John in the City and County of Saint John in the Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on the general business of wholesale and retail merchant, importer, exporter, producer, dealer, manufacturer and refiner of oils of all kinds, greases, chemicals, petroleum and the by-products thereof, to buy, sell and deal in oils, crude and refined of all kinds and for all purposes, greases, motor lubricants, natural gas and other minerals, mineral sub-
