Notice is hereby given under Section 28 of the Forest Firez Act of 1918 that the following regulations shall be in effect in regard to the burning of slash and debris in the Province of New Brunswick during the Close Season April 15th to October 15th.

SIASH BURNING—In accordance with the revised policy of encouraging Fall
