## Letters Patent Granted

### "CITY FUEL, LIMITED"

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under the New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916, and Amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Eighteenth day of June, A. D. 1924, incorporating John Trainor, Coal Merchant; Harry A. Foshay, Coal Merchant; and James B. Dever, Barrister; all of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John, and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on a general business in coal, coke, peat, oil, wood and fuel of all kinds; as a wholesale and retail merchant, importer, exporter and dealer, to purchase, sell and deal in coal, coke, oil, peat, wood and other fuels.

To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, coal mines and other fuel deposits, develop and operate the same, lease, sell or otherwise dispose of them or any of them and the products thereof.

To act as agent for coal or other fuel dealers and to sell all kinds of fuel for them at commission or for such remuneration as may be agreed upon.

To store and otherwise, keep coal, coke, oil, peat, wood and all kinds of fuel for remuneration.

To purchase, build, charter, equip, load on commission, repair and hire steam or other ships and vessels of all kinds and to construct by lease and otherwise acquire railways or other means of transportation to and from any place where any of the Company's operations are carried on and operate the same in connection with its own business upon lands owned or controlled by the Company.

To manufacture, import, export, buy, sell, refine, compound and deal in chemicals, dye-stuffs, cements, super phosphates, fertilizers, coal-tar, coal tar products, and derivatives and all by-products of coal separately or in combination and under all conditions and at all stages of preparation and manufacture.

To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any of the assets, business, property, privileges, contracts, rights, obligations and liabilities of any company, society, partnership or person carrying on any part of the business which this Company is authorized to carry on or possessed of property suitable for the purposes of this Company and to pay for the same in cash or in shares of this Company or partly in cash and partly in shares and to consolidate or amalgamate with any other company having objects similar to those of this Company in whole or in part.

To carry on any other business whether manufacturing or otherwise capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with its business or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the Company's property or rights.

To acquire, hold, mortgage, sell and convey any real estate requisite for the carrying on of the undertakings of the Company.

To exercise its corporate capacity in any part of the world.

To buy, sell, mortgage, transfer, hypothecate and otherwise deal in shares of the capital stock of the Company.
